# SAKE

Sake is a Japanese alcohol made by fermenting rice. The individual rice grains are polished to varying levels to remove the hard bran coating. The degree to which the bran is removed effects the fermenting process and further distinguishes the different styles of Sake; **Junmai, Honjozo, Ginjo, Daiginjo**. Slightly different to wine, Sake is produced using a process more similar to brewing where the rice starch is converted into sugars and rather than brewers yeast the mystical Koji mould is added to kick start the process. The master Sake producers of Japan are exceptionally skilled, revered worldwide and produce stunning variations in flavour.

## JUNMAI

Often with a richer, fuller flavour, these Sakes are made purely with rice, water and koji mould with no additional alcohol added. At least 30% of the rice grain must be polished away to be considered Junmai

## HONJOZO

Generally lighter than Junmai a Honjozo Sake has a small amount of distilled alcohol added during the brewing process. Again, at least 30% of the rice grain must be polished away to be considered Honjozo.

## GINJO

Lighter, more complex and fragrant, often with fruit notes, Ginjo Sakes are premium Sakes. At least 40% of the rice grain must be polished away to be considered Ginjo and a large amount of this process is carried out by hand. Ginjos can be classified both Junmai or Honjozo.

## DAIGINJO

Produced in small batches, Daiginjo Sakes are ultra premium. At least 50% of the rice grain must be polished away to be considered Daiginjo and some are so polished that only 20% of the original rice grain remains. Again a large amount of the process is carried out by hand. Daiginjos can be classified both Junmai or Honjozo although the majority are Junmai as the craft is so highly skilled it is deemed a shame to sully the purity of the process.

## UMESHU

A Sake that is sweetened with Japanese Plums, almost a more classic liqueur.

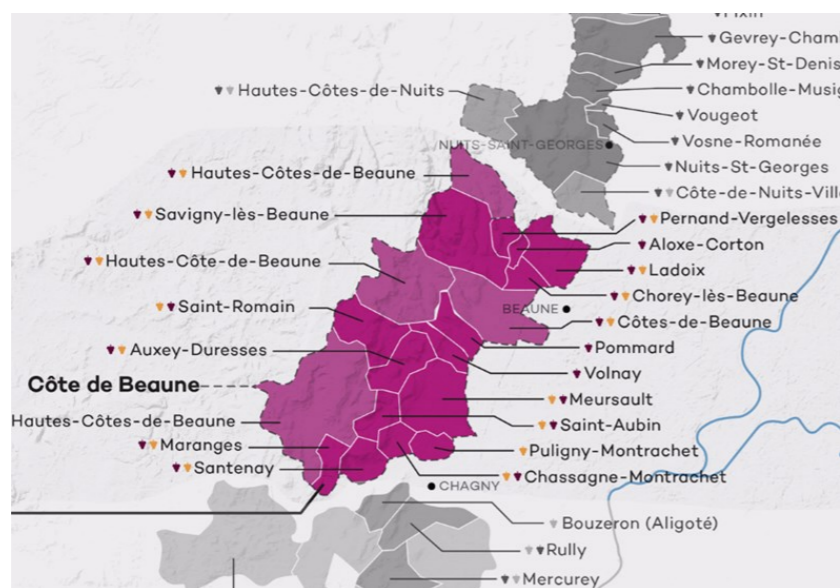

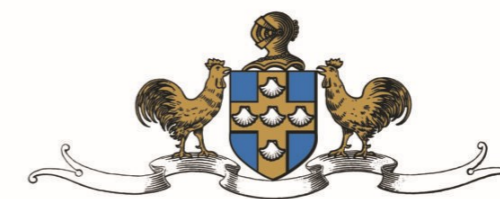

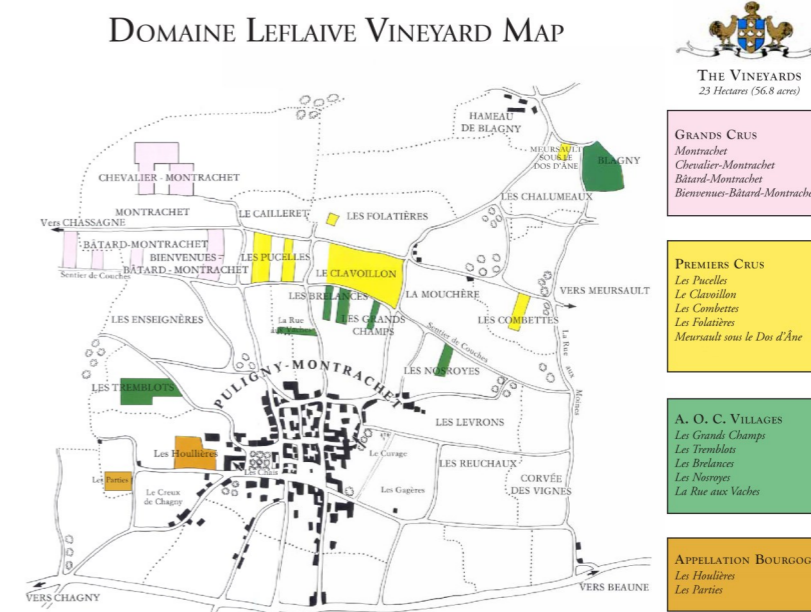
