Bowood House Exhibition

'Ladies of the House: Eighteenth-Century Women at Bowood'

Eighteenth-century and early nineteenth-century women played an important role in the shaping of the Lansdowne family and the family estates.

This exhibition will explore what life was like for women above and below stairs during this period, examining education, the creative arts and recording family history, alongside building a composite picture of how a house was run.

Garden Exhibition

'Bowood in Bloom: A Botanical Portfolio'

Amicus Botanicus has been invited by Lord Kerry to create botanical art inspired by plants from the Bowood Gardens and Arboretum for an exhibition in the Garden Studio, located within the Walled Garden in 2027.

Entitled 'Bowood in Bloom: A Botanical Portfolio', the exhibition will feature works of art that capture moments in nature and highlight environmental discovery. Amicus Botanicus is an acclaimed international society of botanical artists formed in 2006 by graduates of the Botanical Painting Diploma Course at the English Gardening School and Chelsea School of Botanical Art. Based in the UK the group acts as a supportive, creative and interactive platform to promote high-standard, detailed botanical art.
