Discover Bowood House



Steeped in history, Bowood House has been home to the Lansdowne family since 1754 and has seen vast changes over the years.

A visit to the House & Gardens can be tailored to suit both those wishing to spend a full day or an enjoyable short visit between other attractions.

Highlights include:

- Queen Victoria's wedding chair.
- Napoleon's death mask.
- Laboratory in which Dr. Joseph Priestley identified Oxygen gas.
- Collection of art and historical treasures.





House Tour

Adult (17+) & Senior (60+): £18.00

Your guide will uncover the history of Bowood House and the evolution of the wider Estate.

TOUR INCLUSIONS:

- Admission to Bowood House & Gardens.
- 60-minute tour to include; sculpture gallery, orangery, library, chapel, laboratory and exhibition rooms.
(excludes the private areas of the House.)

The History of Bowood Talk

Adult (17+) & Senior (60+): £16.00

An introductory talk, providing an outline of the 270-year history of Bowood under the stewardship of the Lansdowne family. (Option to request this as a seated talk, delivered within the Chapel).

Talk inclusions:

- Admission to Bowood House & Gardens.
- Lasts approx. 20 minutes, with additional 10 minutes for Q&As.

Following any House Tour or Talk, visitors have the opportunity to continue with self-guided access of the House, Gardens and Pleasure Grounds, (including the Arboretum, Doric Temple, Cascade and Hermit's Cave). Access to the Walled Garden is available from 12:00-16:30. Access to the House & Terrace Shop is from 11:00.

Does your Group have a specific interest?

House Tours can be requested to focus on a specific theme to suit your group, i.e. Priestley's Scientific Discovery, Art - The Watercolour Collection, War Time to incl. Napoleonic memorabilia or Bowood's historical connection to the Royal Family.

Garden Tours



A guided tour of the gardens surrounding Bowood House, including the Terrace Garden plus exclusive access in the Walled Garden.

Commencing from the Italianate Terrace Garden at Bowood House, the tour will be conducted by one of our experienced guides who will walk you through the upper and lower terraces.

The tour continues along the East Border, then enters the Walled Garden to explore all four acres, each distinctly different in design and function.

All tours are tailored to suit the season and the flowers in bloom, from the cascading wisteria to the vibrant wall of roses.

Only morning garden tours have exclusive access to the Walled Garden, prior to general opening between 12:00–16:30.

Following the tour, visitors have the opportunity to continue with self-guided access of the House, Gardens and Pleasure Grounds (including the Arboretum, Doric Temple, Cascade and Hermit's Cave). Access to the House & Terrace Shop is from 11:00.

Historic Parkland & Arboretum Tour



Bowood is considered to be one of 'Capability' Brown's finest landscapes.

An expert guide will lead you through the Pleasure Grounds to explore how Bowood's landscape and architecture has evolved over the years.

Commencing from the East Lawn at Bowood House, the tour walks through the Arboretum, down to the Lake to view the Cascade and Doric Temple, while exploring all the wider aspects of the historic landscape.

Woodland Garden

Friday 3rd April - Sunday 7th June



Located just two miles from Bowood House, the spectacular Woodland Garden is a separate attraction to Bowood House & Gardens.

Follow the 'Walk of the Week' amongst the bluebells in April, the magnificent magnolias and amazing azaleas in early May, and rhododendrons throughout May.

Self-guided visits through the 30-acre Woodland Garden, each step opens a new vista of breathtaking beauty, from the initial detail of the individual flower to the grand sweep of colours formed by hundreds of shrubs.

Perhaps you may wish to extend your visit to the House & Gardens?

Located approximately a five minute drive from the Woodland Garden, discover the House, Gardens and Grounds (including the Arboretum, Doric Temple, Cascade and Hermit's Cave).

Helpful Information & Prices

Opening dates & times:

Bowood House & Gardens is open daily, from Friday 27th March to Sunday 1st November 2026, at 10:30. Groups can arrive early from 10:00/10:15.

Bowood House and Terrace Shop opens at 11:00.

Admission costs to Bowood House & Gardens includes; Bowood House, Gardens and Pleasure Grounds (including the Arboretum, Doric Temple, Cascade and Hermit's Cave). Access to the Walled Garden is available for all visitors, 12:00 – 16:30 daily.

We do not open the admission gates until 10:30 however the Café by the car park is open from 10:00 should the group wish to purchase any refreshments prior to entry. Last entry into Bowood House, The Stables and the Terrace Shop is 16:00 and these areas close at 16:30 and all other areas by 17:30 (Car Park closes at 17:45).

The Woodland Garden is open from Friday 3rd April to Sunday 7th June. Free parking for all visitors, including coaches, is available at Bowood House & Gardens and the Woodland Garden. Full details will be provided prior to your visit.

Booking your visit:

The minimum group size is 15 people. All prices in this brochure are based on per person and include VAT, prices are correct upon going to print and are subject to change without notice.

Accessibility:

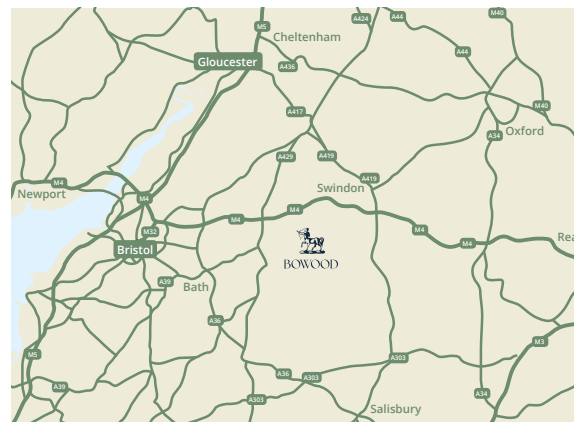

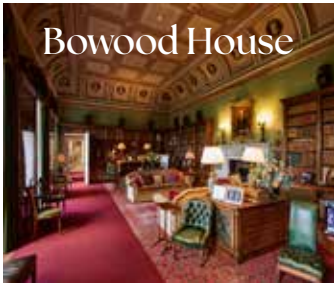
