### The Best Sparkling & Prosecco

#### Quartese, Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore, Ruggeri, Italy, NV

**95%Glera, 3% Perera, 2% Verdiso | 11%ABV ..... 49.00**

This is a seriously classy, brut prosecco, that comes exclusively from some of Valdobbiadene's finest vineyards, giving it a fabulously concentrated nectarine and apricot fruit character, which lingers on the palate far longer than does a 'typical' prosecco. With its creamy mousse of miniscule bubbles, this is an absolute joy to drink - we can't recommend it highly enough! (ve/v)

#### Prosecco DOC Rose Treviso Argeo Brut, Ruggeri, Valdobbiadene, Italy 2023

**85%Glera, 15% Pinot Nero | 11.5%ABV ..... 49.00**

Local white grape glera has been blended with 15% pinot nero (pinot noir) grown in the high altitude vineyards near the town of Valdobbiadene, northeast Italy. The pinot nero has added delicate notes of strawberry and raspberry, there's a lively mousse and refreshing finish. A premium party prosecco. (ve/v)

#### Greyfriars Vineyards Sparkling Cuvée, Surrey, UK, NV

**60% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Meunier | 12% ABV .....55.00**

Discover this English sparkling white wine from Greyfriars Vineyard, reflecting the heritage of the wonderful landscape of the Surrey North Downs. Blending together the three traditional 'champagne' varieties; Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, from 2014, 2015 and 2016 vintages, the NV sparkling cuvée was left to age in bottle for two years on its lees. (ve/v)

#### Cartizze Val d'Oca Valdobbiadene Superiore di Cartizze DOCG, Veneto, Italy, NV

**100% Glera | 11.5% ABV .....65.00**

With its 107 hectares of land, Cartizze is the most famous and reputable cru of the entire region. Located on the hills of San Pietro di Barbozza, Saccol and Santo Stefano, this area is perfectly suited for the cultivation of grapes thanks to its microclimate, location and quality of the land. The wines produced here are known for their finesse and elegance. This bubbly confirms just that; it is a delightfully smooth drink.

**100% Riesling | 0.0%..... 30.00**

Impressively tasty alcohol-free Riesling with flavours of citrus and rhubarb and an aromatic, overarching squirt of lime.



## Champagne

### Lanson Père et Fils, France, 2017

**35% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 15% Pinot Meunier | 12.5% ABV ..... 79.00**

Lanson Père et Fils is a refined and a fancy evolution of the classic Lanson Black Label. The blend is made from a selection of the best crus from ten different vintages and is aged in the cellars for a minimum of four years. (ve/v)

### Lanson Le Rosé

**53% Pinot Noir, 32% Chardonnay, 15% Pinot Meunier | 12.5% ABV ..... 102.00**

Le Rosé benefits from an addition of 7% still Pinot noir from Bouzy (Grand Cru) that gives the wine a pale salmon colour and a lovely red fruits flavour. (ve/v)

### Perrier-Jouët Blason Rosé

**25% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 25% Pinot Meunier | 12% ABV ..... 120.00**

A fantastic rosé brut champagne showing hints of strawberry and red fruits on the nose and a rich long palate. A delicious blend of rose and orange flowers with sensual freshness and full-bodied aromas. Pomegranates, pears, apricots, blood oranges, the fragrances of mature red fruits; a juicy and generous blend that gives way to notes of biscuit, butter and pastries. (ve/v)

### Armand de Brignac Ace of Spades Gold NV

**40% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Meunier | 12.5% ABV ..... 500.00**

In a famous gold pewter bottle, this champagne is marvellous, complex and full-bodied, with a bouquet that is both fresh and lively. It's sumptuous, racy fruit character is perfectly integrated with the wine's subtle brioche accents. (ve/v)

### Armand de Brignac Ace of Spades Rosé NV

**20% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 40% Pinot Meunier | 12.5% ABV ..... 650.00**

One of the best blended pink champagnes ever conceived. It is presented in a beautiful bottle that is a gleaming pink/gold colour with the Ace of Spades logo branded across the front of the bottle. (ve/v)

## Rosé Wines

### Rosato Terre Siciliane Connubio, Italy, 2022

**Sicilian Mix blend Varieties | 12.5% ABV ..... 35.00**

Fresh, fragrant rosé, combining strawberries, watermelon and an appetising splash of salt spray

### White Zinfandel, West Coast Swing, California, USA, 2022

**Blend Zinfandel, Muscat | 10% ABV ..... 40.00**

Fresh white Zinfandel from California, mildly sweet yet well balanced, with ripe flavours of peach, mango, strawberry and melon.

### Côtes de Provence Rosé, Domaine de l'Amour, La Vidaubanaise, France, 2022

**40% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Cinsault, 20% Carignan | 12.5% ABV ..... 47.00**

A light peach colour, with a delicate and fruity nose. This wine reveals great aromatic intensity on the palate with powerful aromas of red fruits, and candy. Good body and a long finish.

### Cirò DOC Rosato Organic, Vumbaca Calabria, Italy, 2022

**100% Gaglioppo | 13.5% ABV ..... 50.00**

With a less than 2 hectares, all grapes are harvested and carefully selected by hand. The fermentation takes place in a cold, controlled temperature with soft pressing. Leese are visible on each bottle making this wine an unexpected experience. (ve/v)



## White Wines

### Connubio Bianco Terre Siciliane, Sicily, Italy, 2023

**Sicilian Mix Blend Varieties | 12.5% ABV .....35.00**

Easy drinking white made from Cataratto, a gentle, quaffable Sicilian grape variety; this is lightly perfumed with white blossom and herbs, with refreshing lemon on the tongue.

### Reserve Chardonnay, Tooma River, New South Wales, Australia, 2023

**100% Chardonnay | 13% ABV .....38.00**

Chardonnay thrives in the warm and sun kissed Australian vineyard - delivering an unmistakably vibrant and fruit driven style. This wine is no exception and is packed with grapefruit, lime and melon flavours, all bound up with a zesty, crisp citrus balance which cuts through to the finish.

### Pinot Grigio Venezia Vigna Mescita, Sartori, Italy, 2023

**100% Pinot Grigio | 11% ABV .....38.00**

Fresh and fruity pinot grigio from northern Italy, gently exuding flavours of pears, peaches and nuts and the scent of fresh flowers.

### Sauvignon Blanc IGT Terre Siciliane Molino a Vento, Italy, 2023

**100% Sauvignon Blanc | 12.5% ABV .....38.00**

Exotic sauvignon blanc from Sicily, intensely aromatic with notes of mint, herbs and a mouthful of tropical fruit and Sicilian lemons. (v)

### Stripped Desnudado, Bodegas Alonso, Andalucia, Spain, 2021

**100% Palomino | 12.5% ABV ..... 40.00**

A really light and interesting wine that suits very nicely as an aperitivo, or with a light meal or snack. Mineral and saline, with citrus and flowers. (ve/v)

### Les Mougeottes Chardonnay, IGP, Pays d'Oc, France, 2023

**100% Chardonnay | 13.5% ABV ..... 40.00**

Lemon and vanilla on the nose with a round, fruity body and a hint of vanilla oak character. Has more ripeness than a Macon and more savouriness than the New World, making it ideal by the glass.

### Dragonstone Riesling Off Dry, Germany, 2022

**100% Riesling | 10% ABV ..... 40.00**

The salty touch on the end of this lightly sweet German Riesling delivers a welcome complexity to a juicy, piquant mouthful of pears, pineapples and limes. (ve/v)

### Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Glazebrook Marlborough, New Zealand, 2023

**100% Sauvignon Blanc | 13% ABV .....52.00**

Aromas of freshly cut grass, dragon fruit and peaches. Medium-bodied with more savoury character than the nose lets on. There is a hint of tang to the acidity, which articulates the stone and tropical fruit notes.

### Recit DOCG Roero Arneis, Piedmont, Italy, 2023

**100% Arneis | 13.5% ABV .....50.00**

We are proud to offer this Italian white wine made from 100% Arneis grapes in the Piedmont region of Italy. 'Recit' in the Piedmontese dialect means 'little King'. This Recit is the perfect blend between Arneis' sumptuous palate and the vineyard's minerality. Lively with notes of pear, lemongrass, sugarloaf pineapple, and a pretty saline finish. A succulent beauty. (ve/v)

### Etna Bianco DOC Alta Mora Cusumano, Etna Volcano, Italy, 2022

**100% Carricante | 12.5% ABV .....55.00**

Here is one of the most beautiful interpretations of the white Carricante grape variety, matured for six months on the fine lees. A fresh, dynamic wine from Etna with a multi-faceted aroma of citrus, white peach, yeast, flint and smoke. Cool grapefruit and passion fruit, taut acidity and impressive mineral notes on the dry finish. (ve/v)



**Domaine Roger & Didier Raimbault Sancerre Blanc, Loire, France, 2021**

**100% Sauvignon Blanc | 12.5% ABV .....60.00**

We are delighted to offer this French white wine from the Loire, made with 100% sauvignon blanc grapes. This sancerre is the result of a blend of wines coming from different parcels of two soil types; 'terres blanches' and 'caillottes'. The terre blanches soils give the wine power and a smooth mouth-feel and the caillottes soils provide it with fruit and aromatic finesse. (ve/v)

**Opstal Estate Carl Everson Chenin Blanc, Slanghoek, Breede River Valley, South Africa, 2021**

**100% Chenin Blanc | 13.5% ABV .....65.00**

Discover this South African Chenin from Opstal Estate. The beauty of this wine is even though it stays the same each year (as its harvested from the same single vineyard classified block on the farm), each year is different. These precious 38 year old vines, old French barrels, spontaneous fermentation, and mimimalistic cellar intervention proclaim the Slanghoek terroir. The 2021 vintage shows some restraint at first, but then opens up to show quince, peach and pineapple notes with a freshness and finesse ever present on the palate as yellow peach flavours run through your mouth. (ve/v)

**Organistrum Albarino, Martin Codax, Spain, 2021**

**100% Albarino | 12.5% ABV .....65.00**

Straw yellow colour with intense green highlights. Nose: high aromatic intensity with a first touch of freshness, caramel and cocoa which reminds of the oak influence in the wine. Then the varietal fruit notes take place in a more ripe and soothing way; quince and apple compôte. Palate: Balanced and structured. Round, full-bodied and powerful with a nice balanced acidity thanks to the bâtonnage, as well as spiced and long lasting. (ve/v)

**Pomino Benefizo, Riserva Frescobaldi, Tuscany, Italy, 2022**

**100% Chardonnay | 13.5% ABV .....75.00**

This super Tuscan white from the historical Frescobaldi estate is a delightful addition to our wine list. Made with 100% Chardonnay grapes, the Benefizio vineyard stands at an altitude of 700m above sea level, is south facing and has mostly sandy soil. Benefizio Reserva offers maximum taste-olfactory expression in both elegance and harmony.

**Quintessence-R Crozes Hermitage, Rhône Valley, France, 2022**

**100% Roussanne | 13.0% ABV .....80.00**

An exceptional white Crozes-Hermitage with real wow-factor. This small batch wine is listed in a dozen or so Michelin starred restaurants in France. We have a small allocation of this rare, coveted 100% Roussanne wine, of which only 980 bottles are produced each year. Partial barrel fermentation as well as ten months ageing, gives this wine complexity which shines through in a nut-buttery nose, with a delightful splattering of vanilla, yellow apple and soft lemon. The delicate ripe lemon aromas sharpen into a lemongrass and fresh apple palate.

**Puligny Montrachet, Alain Chavy, Burgundy, France, 2021**

**100% Chardonnay | 13% ABV .....150.00**

Exotic, beguiling white Burgundy, bursting with ripe tropical fruit, including pineapple and guava, balanced by a concentrated jet of lime-flavoured acidity and a fragrance of spicy oak. (v)



## Red Wines

### Connubio Rosso Terre Siciliane, Sicily, Italy, 2023

**Blend Sicilian Varieties | 12.5% ABV .....35.00**

A blend of red Sicilian varieties that's textured, fruity and flavourful, with floral notes and flavours of raspberry and redcurrant. Grapes grow in vineyards high on the hills of the Valle del Belice that are situated between 100 and 300 metres high in the South West of Sicily. The grapes are of indigenous red varieties and are carefully selected. A milder climate, with high temperature variation influences the ripening of the fruit and ensures aromas are retained.

### Pinot Noir Siciliane Nerello Mascalese, Molino a Vento, Gibellina, Sicily, Italy, 2023

**100% Nerello Mascalese | 13.5% ABV .....38.00**

The Nerello Mascalese vineyards are planted in sandy soil across western Sicily. Vines are subjected to the Guyot pruning system, after which grapes are harvested by hand throughout September and October. Fermentation then occurs for 12 to 15 days at 24-30°C heat, with daily pump overs and racking. The wine is matured in stainless steel tanks, with minimal oak contact to preserve the fresh fruit flavours. (ve/v)

### Estacion 1883 Cabernet Franc, Trapiche, Argentina, 2022

**100% Bonardo | 14% ABV .....42.00**

Fruity Argentinian red, packed with plums, strawberries, finishing with a lick of liquorice and a wisp of smoke. Ideal with grilled red meats. (ve/v)

### Los Companeros Shiraz Tempranillo, Pikes, Australia, 2021

**85% Shiraz, 15% Tempranillo | 14% ABV .....42.00**

A lively presentation of red and blue berry fruits, accompanied by notes of five spice and cinnamon. Complexity arises from charry oak and subtle herbal tones. The palate echoes the soft blue and red berry elements, with shiraz delivering plush, spicy-sweet fruit, while tempranillo adds a delightfully rustic, savoury tannin profile.

### A Descoberta Tinto, Casa da Passarella, Portugal, 2021

**40% Touriga Nacional, 40% Tinto Roriz, 20% Alforcheiro | 14% ABV .....45.00**

Fruity Argentinian red, packed with plums, strawberries, finishing with a lick of liquorice and a wisp of smoke. Ideal with grilled red meats. (ve/v)

### Rosso di Montepulciano, Poliziano, Montepulciano, Tuscany, Italy, 2022

**80% Sangiovese, 20% Merlot | 14% ABV .....48.00**

Absolutely stunning; finesse, power and precision merge. Intense damson, black cherry, fine tannins, fresh acidity, subtle oak. Unique Rosso di Montepulciano, not declassified Vino Nobile. Carefully chosen vines for sumptuous, rich delight. 80% sangiovese, 20% merlot, crafted to perfection. This wine has a nice balance of complexity and drinkability and is therefore enjoyable throughout the meal. (ve/v)

### Primitivo di Manduria DOC Villa Santera Leone de Castris, Puglia, Italy, 2022

**100% Primitivo | 15% ABV .....55.00**

Iconic for all southern Italians. Best known for this full round body and strong wines, Leone de Castris is allegedly the father of all Primitivos. In business since 1665. Very deep red in colour turning almost purplish. The nose reveals a rich perfume of plum, black cherry and spices like ginger and vanilla. On the palate it's full-bodied, velvety and well balanced.



- Terra Remota Tan Natural, Tempranillo Syrah, Catalunya, Spain, 2021**  
**Blend Tempranillo, Syrah | 12.5% ABV .....55.00**  
Looking for an outstanding natural wine? Tan Natural fits the bill. This frank wine embodies minimal intervention and ancient winemaking techniques. Grapes are gently processed in stainless steel tanks, preserving their true character. Delicate crushing and brief skin contact ensure excellence in every sip. Terra Remota's dedication to natural processes shines through. Alive is the best word to describe this wine. Beginning with the violet red that is seen when pouring a glass. Or the intense and exuberant fruit reminiscent of raspberries, cherries and blueberries along with wildflowers for Emporda such as poppies and chamomile in bloom. (ve/v)
- Carus Vini Baldero Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy, 2018**  
**Blend Sangiovese, Merlot | 14% ABV .....55.00**  
We are proud to introduce this well refined, beautifully poised Chianti, an Italian red wine made from a blend of sangiovese and merlot grapes. The balance of savoury flavours and fruit as well as its moderate body that is neither too heavy nor too light will tick all the boxes for lovers of traditional Chianti Classico who also seek out fruit. The harvest is done by hand to maintain the integrity. Best if decanted 0 minutes prior to enjoying. (ve/v)
- Opstal Estate Carl Everson Cape Red Blend, Slanghoek, Breede River Valley, South Africa, 2018**  
**Blend Pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Cinsault | 13.5% ABV .....55.00**  
This South African red wine is made from a blend of pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz and Cinsault grapes. The Carl Everson labels are the flagship, cream of the crop wines from the Opstal Estate. This particular red blend provides lots of spice, smoke and fruit compôte flavours in a nicely rounded but gently structured palate. Best if decanted 1.5 to 2 hours prior to enjoying. (ve/v)
- Malbec Siciliano Rosso di Ludovico Riserva, Orestadi, Gibellina, Sicily, Italy, 2019**  
**90% Nero d'Avola, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon | 14.5% ABV .....57.00**  
An outstanding, full and fruity Sicilian red flagship wine from Tenute Orestadi, also known as the Sicilian Malbec spilling over with prunes, mulberry and black cherry, the dark fruit complementing spicy aromas of liquorice, tobacco and pepper. Fermentation occurs at a controlled temperature, between 25-26°C and is characterised by frequent pumping-over and racking. Once maceration is complete, the wine is placed in oak barrels where it undergoes malolactic fermentation, and matures for about 12 to 14 months. Ageing is completed with the bottle lying on its side for about 10 to 12 months. (ve/v)
- Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge Organic, Domaine Chante Cigale, Rhône, France, 2022**  
**80% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 5% Mourvèdre, 5% Cinsault | 15% ABV .....80.00**  
Directly from parcels with 60 year old vines, this wonderful Châteauneuf du Pape gifts a nose of spice and dark fruits followed by a rich, ripe palate with layers of fruit and spice. With judges like The Gilbert Scott's Juan Manuel Marcos Perez describing this as 'outstanding and very complex', it's no surprise that this took home not only a gold medal but a Critic's Choice award too. Best if decanted 3 to 4 hours prior to enjoying.
- Brunello di Montalcino, Il Poggione, Tuscany, Italy, 2017**  
**100% Sangiovese | 14.5% ABV .....85.00**  
Brunello is the prince of Montalcino wines, produced exclusively from Sangiovese grapes picked by hand from the oldest vines in the farm. Old vineyards planted with the cordon spur system at an altitude of 150 and 450 metres above sea level. A seductive Brunello di Montalcino, so fragrant with fruit, leather and spice you could wear it as aftershave. Best if decanted 2 hours prior to enjoying. (ve/v)





**Valle Arriba. 'El Pucareno' Malbec de Altura, Calchaqui Valley, Argentina, 2017**  
**100% Malbec | 14.5% ABV .....85.00**

Over to the Salta region of Argentina where Valle Arriba's winemaker Raul Davalos knows in detail every corner of the high Calchaqui Valley, its soils, rivers and mountains. It is through this knowledge of the area, that has allowed him to cultivate three vineyards that are at such high altitudes above sea level (accessible only by crossing dry riverbeds). Two of these vineyards lie between 2400 and 2600 metres above sea level and this is where Raul cultivates two exceptional Malbecs from. These wines are like hens' teeth, where only several hundred bottles are produced each year for each cuvée. Best if decanted 2 to 4 hours prior to enjoying. (ve/v)

**Gianfranco Alessandria, Barolo San Giovanni, Piedmont, Italy, 2019**  
**100% Nebbiolo | 14.5% ABV .....135.00**

This is a flagship wine, which will impress anyone who loves a big bold red. Described by Italians as the Ferrari of grapes, this is a 100% Nebbiolo from the single oldest vineyards in the area, located in MGA San Giovanni Monforte village. With a south-east exposure, these vines are ~70 years old. Best if decanted a 2 to 4 hours prior to enjoying.

**Argiolas Turriga, Isola dei Nuraghi, Sardinia, Italy, 2019**  
**Blend Cannonau, Carignano, Bovale Sardo, Malvasia Nera | 14.5% ABV .....155.00**

Recognised as one of the greatest producers of Sardinian wines, the Argiolas family has been magnifying the terroir of this island, located in the western part of the Italian peninsula, since 1918. From generation to generation, this family, who owns 5 estates, has been producing fine Italian wines that are imbued with their passion and deep respect for the terroir. Delicate and well balanced, the palate is seduced by this wine's structure, its suppleness and its persistence. Best if decanted 2 to 4 hours prior to enjoying. (ve/v)

**Saint-Julien, Chateau Talbot 4ème Cru Classe, Bordeaux, France, 2015**  
**66% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 3% Cabernet Franc | 13.5%ABV .....180.00**

Gorgeous, justly renowned St Julien, aromatic with blackcurrants, leather and herbs, all enhanced by chocolate, spice and smoked oak on the palate. Hand harvesting, using lot selection. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at temperature controlled. 3 weeks maceration. Ageing in oak barrels with 50% new barrels. Janusz Sasiadek of Bottles & Battles was happy with this wine: "This has a great, intense nose that feels very elegant. There's mature fruits balanced with great acidity. Very elegant tannins with a nice twist of spice. A great wine for the dinner table but I'd happily drink it alone." Best if decanted 3 to 4 hours prior to enjoying. (v)

**Terra Remota Usted, Catalunya, Spain, 2016**  
**65% Black Grenache, 35% Syrah | 12.5% ABV .....235.00**

This is the reason winemaker Marc Bournazeau gets up in the morning. This is your Christmas Day wine. Wine enjoyment doesn't get much better than this. Named 'Usted', Spanish for 'You', this is a very small batch wine from Terra Remota, Catalunya, a hot and dry granatic region. Each bottle is numbered. This is a truly unique Grenache experience and a truly phenomenal wine that's made to impress.

**Amarone Classico DOC, Bertani, Veneto, Italy, 2013**  
**80% Corvina, 20% Rondinella | 15.5% ABV .....240.00**

Bertani is considered one of the fathers and kings of the Amarone. Silky Amarone, the rich textured dry red of the Veneto, like a savoury port, with flavours of prunes and Morello cherries and a heady bouquet of nuts, tobacco, dried flowers and sweet spices. The vines are vertical-trellised and Guyot trained, with a planting density of 5000 vines/ha. The grapes come from the Tenuta Novare vineyards at Arbizzano di Negrar, in the heart of the Valpolicella Classica area, with calcareous-marl soils, devoted exclusively to the production of Amarone. The harvest is done by hand in the second week of September. After careful bunch selection, the grapes are taken to the drying rooms and laid in a single layer on bamboo racks. Classico Bertani ages in Slavonian oak barrels, with an average capacity of 60hl, for about six years. Then it matures in the bottle for at least 12 months. (ve/v)
