Terra Remota Usted DO Empordà, 2016......235.00

A distinguished red blend from the Empordà region, crafted from 65% Black Grenache and 35% Syrah. This wine showcases a deep garnet hue with cacao highlights. On the nose, it offers complex and elegant aromas of ripe black fruits, truffle, cacao, soft spices, vanilla, cherry and smoky notes. The palate is refined and expressive, with flavours of ripe black and red fruits, spices, truffle, cacao and lead. The finish is long and salivating, marked by elegance and finesse. The tannins are silky and melted, contributing to a harmonious structure.

Bertani Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOCG, 2013 ......240.00

A quintessential expression of Amarone, crafted from a blend of 80% Corvina Veronese and 20% Rondinella grapes. This wine showcases a deep ruby-red colour with garnet nuances. On the nose, it offers aromas of ripe cherries, plums and Morello cherries, complemented by notes of tea leaves, licquorice and spices. The palate is full-bodied and intense, with velvety tannins and a long, warming finish. Aged for 7 years in large Slavonian oak barrels, followed by at least 12 months in bottle, this Amarone exemplifies Bertani's commitment to tradition and quality.
