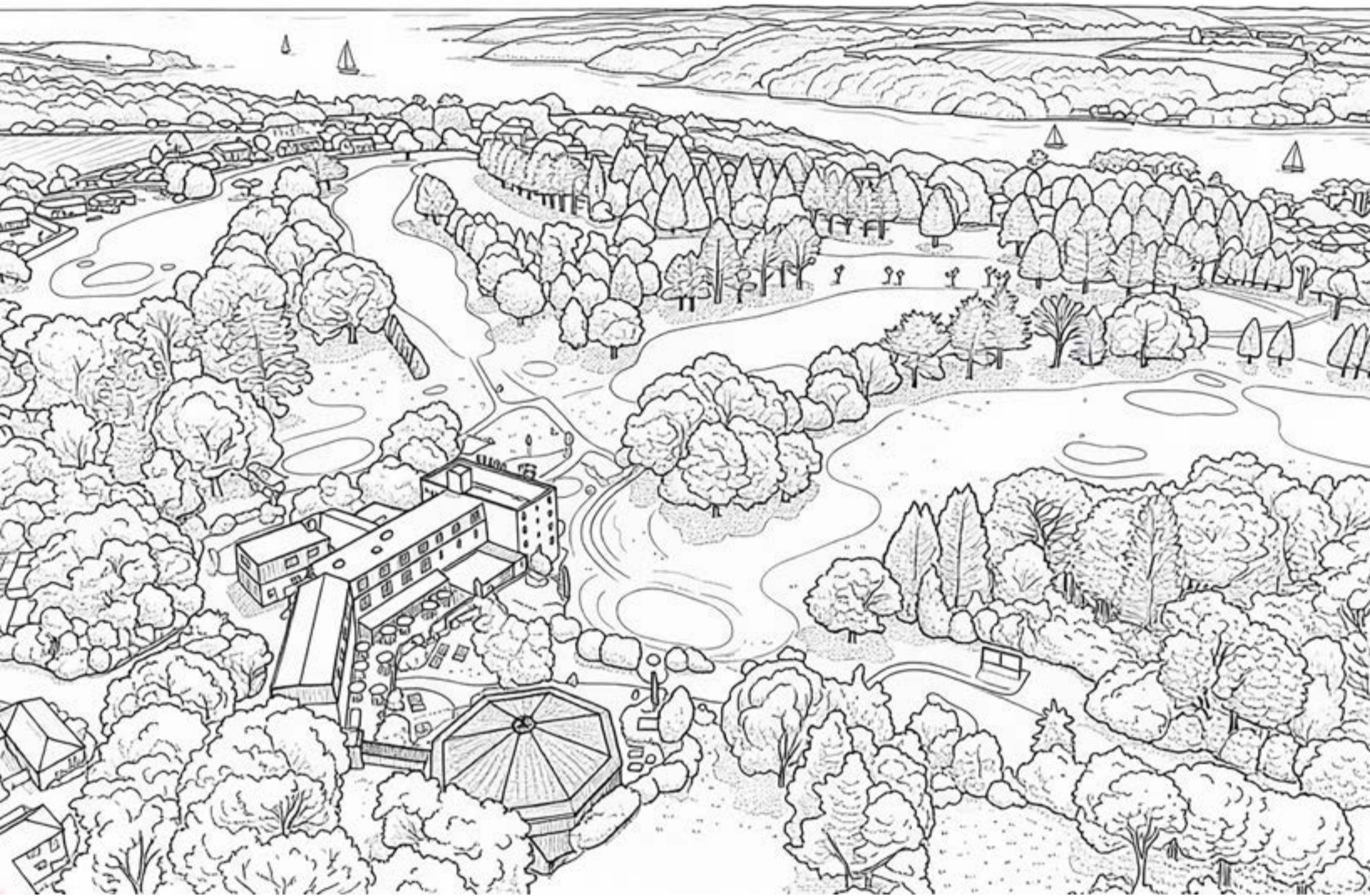

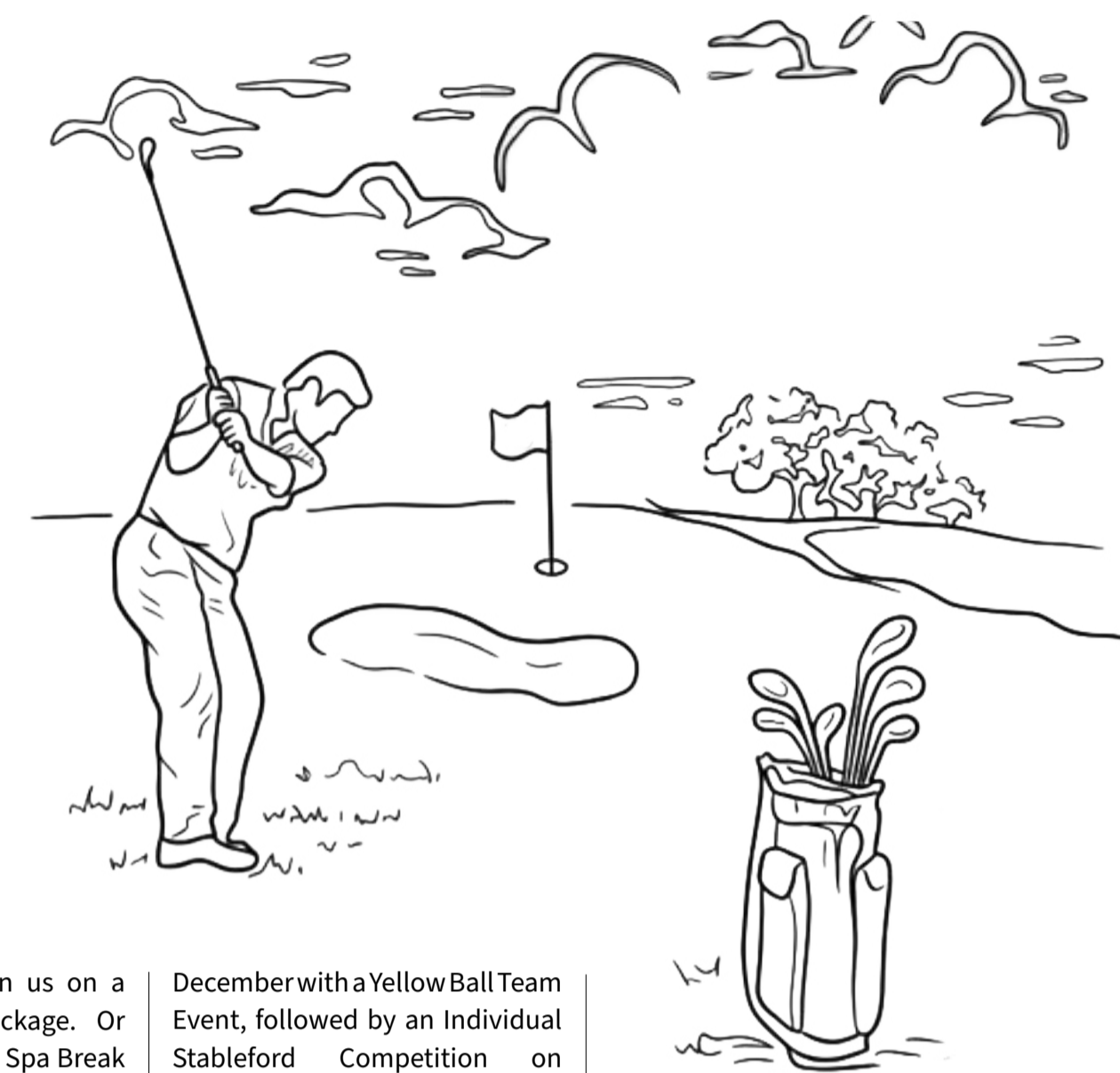

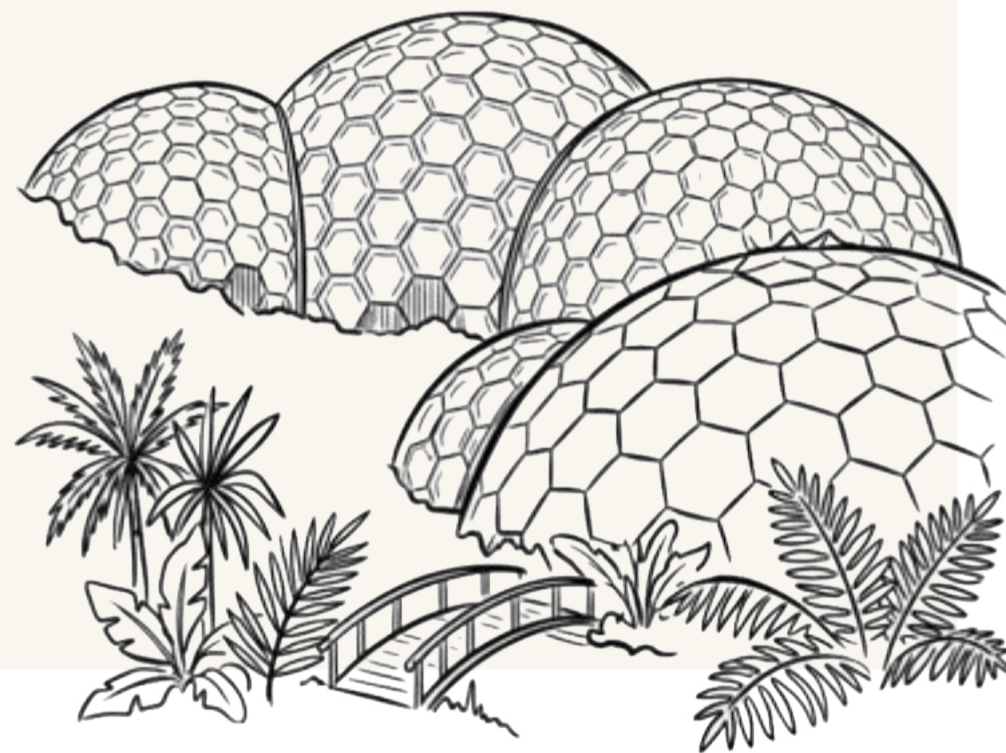

within easy reach, then return to the comfort of Budock Vean for cosy evenings relaxing by the fire.



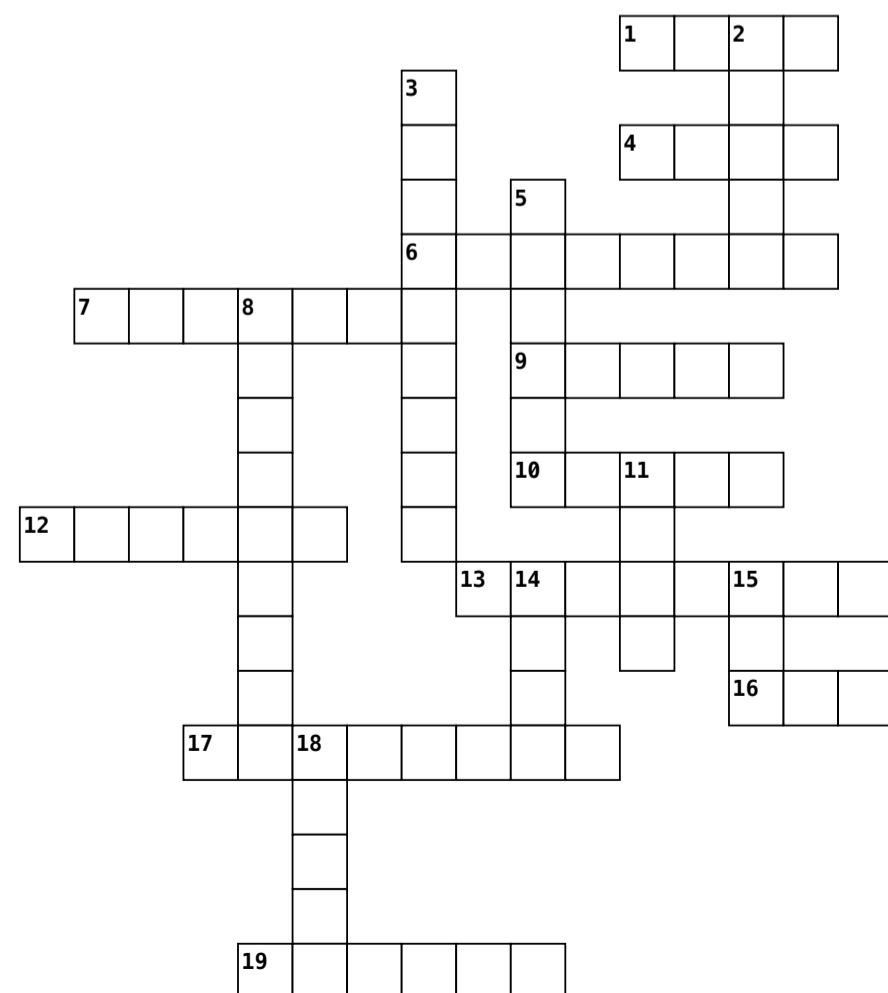

Learn the lingo

The Cornish language, known as 'Kernewek', is an integral part of Cornwall's rich cultural heritage. This Celtic language, closely related to Welsh and Breton, dates back more than a thousand years and offers a deep connection to the region's history and identity. While Cornish fell out of common use by the late 18th century, a revival movement in the 20th century brought it back to life, and it is now recognised as a living language. Today, Cornish isn't just a relic of the past; the language is celebrated through festivals, music, poetry, and an active community of speakers dedicated to its preservation. During the Christmas

season, Kernewek takes on a festive role, connecting Cornish traditions to the wider celebration of winter holidays. Many families and communities use Cornish greetings and songs, keeping the language alive in seasonal contexts. From carols sung in Cornish to holiday decorations labelled in Kernewek, Christmas provides a joyful way to share and experience the language. It's also common to see Christmas events, markets, and performances incorporating Cornish phrases, bringing both locals and visitors closer to Cornwall's cultural heritage.
