Fuller than Pinot Noir from Burgundy, it has a warm, rich nose with aromas of dark wild cherry and just a hint of toasty oak. The palate is nicely balanced with an exciting, savoury bitterness provided by ripe, tasty tannins. 13% vol

22 CLEEFS CLASSIC CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Western Cape, South Africa

This is a quintessential South African Cabernet Sauvignon. Enticing dark fruit on the nose followed by a textured palate with soft, supple tannins and a hint of spice. 15% vol

23 CHÂTEAU SERGANT, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

Oak ageing of 12 months has greatly impacted this wines power, structure and long ageing potential. On the nose, fresh notes of raspberries and blackberry jam are followed by vanilla and spice. A great length and depth of flavour takes over and hints of chocolate, smoke and caramel offer a lovely savoury nature. A wine to really savour. 14.5% vol

Pungent aromatic nose with heaps of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum. Lovely clean, crisp freshness to the bouquet. The palate is rounded, smooth and perfectly balanced.
