 In the top rank of Champagne houses, the style is light and elegant. Real finesse tops yeasty, fresh bread undertones, taut apple and citrus fruit. Complex, absolute purity. 12.% vol
  
- 2 **LAURENT-PERRIER CUVÉE ROSÉ, Champagne, France** Magnum **£190**  
Bottle **£100**  
 Pale and interesting, yet full and flavoursome. A classic wine in an iconic bottle. 12% vol
  
- 4 **LAURENT-PERRIER GRAND SIÈCLE, Champagne, France** Bottle **£300**  
 It has a bright colour, with a brilliant yellow hue. Its subtle aromas of honey, hazelnuts, grilled almonds and brioche, make this the perfect companion for refined dishes. 12% vol

 Refreshing and vibrant bubbles with aromas of gooseberry, greengage and pineapple. Infused with a unique and zesty elixir or uplifting vitamins, minerals and botanical. 0.5% vol

# WHITE WINE

- 8 **CORETO WHITE, Lisboa, Portugal** Bottle £26 | Carafe £13.5  
A combination of delicate aromas, delicious apple and grapefruit flavours and a lively finish. Something a bit different from the normal offering and well worth discovering. 12% vol

- 9 **FRUNZA PINOT GRIGIO, Banat, Romania** Bottle £28 | Carafe £15  
Lovely, opulent notes of grapefruit and peach. Light in body with melon and apple flavours on the palate resulting in a citrusy acidity. This is what Pinot Grigio should be. 12% vol

- 10 **GRAVEL & LOAM SAUVIGNON BLANC, Marlborough, New Zealand** Bottle £36 | Carafe £18.5  
Intense gooseberry aromas alongside fresh herbaceous and grassy notes. Vibrant passion fruit, citrus and peach characters with top notes of melon and kiwi balanced with softer apple and white pear flavours. Well structured zesty acidity with fantastic length and elegance. 13.5% vol

- 11 **LION RIDGE CHENIN BLANC, Western Cape, South Africa** Bottle £28.5  
Leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. 13% vol
- 12 **PICPOUL DE PINET, JEAN LUC COLOMBO, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £38.5  
The nose is rich and subtle, with fresh notes of white flowers. The palate is nicely rounded and very fresh with good structure and a nice palate of aromas. 14%
- 13 **KNIGHTOR CARPE DIEM WHITE, Cornwall, England** Bottle £36  
It is delicate, lively and fresh with aromas of elderflower, nettle and apple. Crisp and clean on the palate with plenty of fruit flavours and a long tangy gooseberry filled finish. 11% vol
- 14 **CHABLIS ALAIN GEOFFROY, Chablis, Burgundy, France** Bottle £55  
Fragrant flowers, fruity aromas with sweet, suave scents. A pronounced mineral character enhances the fruit flavours. 13% vol
- 15 **SANCERRE DOMAINE DE LA PERRIÈRE, Loire, France** Bottle £60  
Cool and grassy with a boisterous touch of gooseberry fruit over a neat mineral base, this offers classic character at a good value. 13.5% vol

## RED WINE

- 16 **CORETO RED, Lisboa, Portugal** Bottle £26 | Carafe £13.5  
 Coreto could easily be your favourite daily wine. Medium-bodied, smooth, balanced alcohol and tannins with fresh herbal notes and berry fruit flavours. 12.5% vol 250ml £8.8

- 17 **TOUT UN FROMAGE MERLOT, South of France** Bottle £30 | Carafe £16  
 Deep garnet colour with vibrant plummy and blackberry fruit that fills the mouth. Soft and supple on the palate, with ripe, rounded fruit and a lovely, juicy finish. 14% vol 250ml £9.5

- 18 **THE BUTCHER OF BUENOS AIRES MALBEC, Mendoza, Argentina** Bottle £31 | Carafe £16  
 Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky smooth mouthfeel. Not a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food yet easy enough to drink on its own. 14% vol 250ml £11

- 19 **VITIS NOSTRA PRIMITIVO, Puglia, Italy** Bottle £32  
 Red fruit with delicate hints of ripe cherry. Well balanced sweetness and acidity. This wine is characterised by a sweet finish. 13.5% vol
- 20 **1000 MILHOJAS CRIANZA, Rioja, Spain** Bottle £34  
 Made from 75% Tempranillo and 25% Garnacha this is an open and friendly Rioja filled with vanilla spice and baked red fruit. Full-bodied but smooth enough to drink on its own. 14% vol
- 21 **VIEILLE MONNAIE PINOT NOIR, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £36  
Fuller than Pinot Noir from Burgundy, it has a warm, rich nose with aromas of dark wild cherry and just a hint of toasty oak. The palate is nicely balanced with an exciting, savoury bitterness provided by ripe, tasty tannins. 13% vol
- 22 **CLEEF'S CLASSIC CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Western Cape, South Africa** Bottle £40  
 This is a quintessential South African Cabernet Sauvignon. Enticing dark fruit on the nose followed by a textured palate with soft, supple tannins and a hint of spice. 15% vol
- 23 **CHÂTEAU SERGANT, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** Bottle £62  
Oak ageing of 12 months has greatly impacted this wine's power, structure and long ageing potential. On the nose, fresh notes of raspberries and blackberry jam are followed by vanilla and spice. A great length and depth of flavour takes over and hints of chocolate, smoke and caramel offer a lovely savoury nature. A wine to really savour. 14.5% vol

- 24 **FALLING PETAL ZINFANDEL ROSÉ, California, USA** Bottle £28 | Carafe £15  
 Falling Petal Zinfandel Rosé conjures up summer in every sip with its delicious flavours of red fruits and peach. 11% vol

- 25 **MAISON BADET CLÉMENT ROSÉ, Languedoc-Roussillon, South of France** Bottle £30 | Carafe £15.50  
 This rosé wine shows a beautiful pale pink colour. Subtle flavours of ripe fruits and dried flowers. Super fresh with a balanced finish. 12.0% vol

- 26 **WHISPERING ANGEL, Côtes de Provence, South of France** Bottle £50  
Pale pink in colour, it has flavours of redcurrant, dried flowers and spices on the nose, with a subtle herbal quality. Dry, with bitter red fruit flavours, it has a firm finish with lingering herbal notes. 13.5% vol

- 27 **DEEN VAT 5 BOTRYTIS SEMILLON DE BORTOLI, Riverina, New South Wales, Australia** 50ml £4  
 De Bortoli Vat 5 is a perfect expression of botrytis: pure luminescent gold in colour, with intense marmalade and dried peel fruit flavours, plus the botrytis honeyed effect. 9.5% vol
- 28 **PEDRO XIMENEZ TRIANA JAVIER HIDALGO, Jerez, Spain** 50ml £6.5  
The colour and complexity of molasses, it is complex, intensely sweet and rich with pronounced raisin flavours. A blockbuster of power and sweetness and irresistibly fascinating. 15% vol
- 29 **TAYLOR'S LATE BOTTLED VINTAGE PORT, Douro, Portugal** 50ml £6  
Pungent aromatic nose with heaps of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum. Lovely clean, crisp freshness to the bouquet. The palate is rounded, smooth and perfectly balanced. Flavours of redcurrant, raspberry and blueberry in abundance, with a delicious hint of black liquorice. The finish is wonderfully long. 20% vol
