## WHITE WINE

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- 13 **Selon Létang Viognier, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £32  
 This Viognier is 'frais'; vinified dry, with honeysuckle and mandarin notes and a pithy clean finish. 13% vol
- 14 **Fincas de Azabache Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja, Spain** Bottle £35  
 This is a real find. White Tempranillo is a fairly 'new' grape variety but is closely linked to the well known red Tempranillo grape grown all over Spain. This style is robust yet unoaked, with apple, stone fruit and a tropical touch. Elegantly balanced with a long finish. 12% vol
- 15 **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie Château L'Oiselinière de la Ramée, Loire, France** Bottle £37  
 Just what a good young Muscadet is all about. A suggestion of sea breeze over new-mown hay, some mineral cool, finished with calm length. 12% vol
- 16 **Terres Rouge Picpoul de Pinet Montagnac, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £38.5  
 This wine expresses the red clay hills and shows rich and generous notes of white flowers and garrigue aromas, with stone fruits, zingy citrus and freshness to top it off! 13% vol
- 17 **Hahn Winery Chardonnay, California, USA** Bottle £52  
 Initial scents of pineapple and mango give way to aromas of pear and vanilla. A rich mouthfeel shows flavours of bananas, baked apples and toffee. A touch of acidity balances a note of sweet butter on the crisp finish. 12.5% vol
- 18 **Chablis Alain Geoffroy, Chablis, Burgundy, France** Bottle £57  
Fragrant flowers, fruity aromas with sweet, suave scents. A pronounced mineral character enhances the fruit flavours. 13% vol
- 19 **Sancerre Domaine de la Perrière, Loire, France** Bottle £60  
 Cool and grassy with a boisterous touch of gooseberry fruit over a neat mineral base, this offers classic character at a good value. 13.5% vol
- 20 **Montagny Louis Latour, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France** Bottle £70  
 Lovely notes of white stone fruits with hints of marzipan and a subtle minerality on the finish. 13% vol

### 21 **Coreto Red, Lisboa, Portugal**



Coreto could easily be your favourite daily wine. Medium-bodied, smooth, balanced alcohol and tannins with fresh herbal notes and berry fruit flavours. 12.5% vol

### 22 **La Croix Grenache Merlot, Languedoc, South of France**



Coming from low yielding fruit, this wine has flavours of red and blackberry fruit, dried herbs as well as a racy acidity. The Merlot adds some softness and roundness in the mid-palate and a ripe juicy finish. 13.5% vol

### 23 **Trueno Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina**



Ruby red with notes of raisins, chocolate, coffee, tobacco and caramel. Smooth and well-balanced, purity of red and blackberry fruits and a lingering finish. 13.5% vol

### 24 **Knightor Carpe Diem Red, Cornwall, England**



Aromas of dark fruit, spices and black pepper, the palate is medium-bodied, fruity with gentle oak. 12% vol

### 25 **Vitis Nostra Primitivo, Puglia, Italy**

Made from 75% Tempranillo and 25% Garnacha this is an open and friendly Rioja filled with vanilla spice and baked red fruit. Full-bodied but smooth enough to drink on its own. 14% vol

### 27 **Vieille Monnaie Pinot Noir, Languedoc, South of France**

Fuller than Pinot Noir from Burgundy, it has a warm, rich nose with aromas of dark wild cherry and just a hint of toasty oak. The palate is nicely balanced with an exciting, savoury bitterness provided by ripe, tasty tannins. 13% vol

### 28 **Terra Iconia Beaujolais, Beaujolais, Burgundy, France**



An abundance of intense berry fruits such as redcurrant, blackberry and blueberry. A subtle, floral peony fragrance lingers on the palate and combines with mineral notes and round, silky tannins to give a balanced glass with a lengthy, fruity finish. 12% vol

### 29 **Côtes du Rhône Rouge M. Chapoutier, Rhône, France**





An intense wine made mainly from Grenache and Syrah, with notes of blackcurrant and raspberry, complemented by hints of white pepper. The wine is juicy, powerful and fruity, with lovely roasted notes and silky, delicate tannins. 14.5% vol

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- 30 **Cleefs Classic Cabernet Sauvignon, Western Cape, South Africa** Bottle £40  
 This is a quintessential South African Cabernet Sauvignon. Enticing dark fruit on the nose followed by a textured palate with soft, supple tannins and a hint of spice. 15% vol
- 31 **Terrazas Reserva Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** Bottle £53  
 Full-bodied yet underpinned by sweet and round tannins. This wine has a juicy finish reminiscent of red and black fruit that provides freshness. 14.5% vol
- 32 **Lyme Bay Pinot Noir, Devon, England** Bottle £60  
Made from the finest fruit in the UK & aged in 30% new oak, this wine displays a complex & intense array of black cherries, raspberries & bramble fruit, underpinned by a subtle toasty oak. 12.5% vol
- 33 **Amarone della Valpolicella Zonin, Veneto, Italy** Bottle £70  
Intense colour leads into an inviting bouquet of wild hedgerow berries. There is a velvety feel and masses of rich sun-dried fruit, spice and integrated balanced tannins. 15.5% vol
- 34 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Colombo & Fille, Rhône, France** Bottle £97  
A big and powerful wine with ripe fruit and gingerbread spice and subtle herbaceous notes. 14% vol

Pungent aromatic nose with heaps of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum. Lovely clean, crisp freshness to the bouquet. The palate is rounded, smooth and perfectly balanced. Flavours of redcurrant, raspberry and blueberry in abundance, with a delicious hint of black liquorice. The finish is wonderfully long. 20% vol
