- 2020 Crianza Rioja**
Vina Salceda, 14.5%

Ruby red colour, with violet hues. Very intense nose. At first, pleasant notes of vanilla, coming from the aging, sweet. Then spices: white pepper, bay leaf and nutmeg. Black fruit. Full mouthfeel, great balance, with particularly good volume and intensity. Crisp acidity that acts as the backbone of the wine and provides a final freshness that invites you to drink again.

This is in homage to the founder and creator of Braille, Maurice de la Sizeranne, who was, along with Chapoutier, also from the village of Tain. Red fruits, blackcurrant and raspberry aromas, fresh and rounded with a baked fruit note on the palate.

WHITE WINES

- 1 **2022 Cannonball Chardonnay**
USA, California, 12.5%

Cannonball does a beautiful job of making a friendly, easygoing and fun Chardonnay, with scents of ripe golden apples, juicy pears and just a hint of citrus. Soft, juicy and creamy-textured, this is a wine that is more about the fruit than the oak - the wood is there, but very much in the background. Overall, the impression is of orchard fruits, ripened to perfection in the benign California sunshine.

The proximity to the sea gives the wine its freshness and saltiness and the granitic soils enhance its natural minerality. The wine is rounded and full-bodied, with a light petulance that adds to its vivacious sense of freshness.
