High above the dramatic Ayrshire coastline surrounded by forests and glens, historic Glenapp Castle is truly a place of nurture and excitement.






First Class Visit

CHILDREN

Children from 5 - 15 years are charged at £295 per night on a full board basis and children 16+ years are charged at half of the above room rates. All charges for children are based on sharing a room with two adults.

TRAVEL AND BOOKING

Glenapp Castle is easily accessible from all main Scottish railway hubs. Private jets can land at Prestwick Airport, which is 55 minutes away, and regular scheduled flights arrive at Glasgow Airport which is one hour thirty minutes away, as well as Edinburgh Airport which is two hours thirty minutes away.
