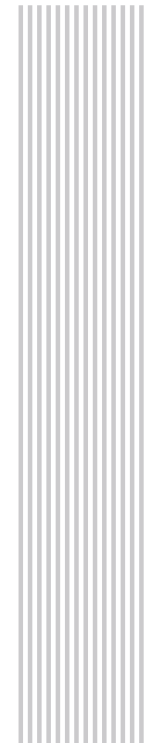

Bombay sapphire gin, grapefruit, rosemary

Helped by the equestrian heritage of the area and a lovely pairing of gin and grapefruit, this gee-gee is sure to get you up and galloping

Smokey Bertie

Jamesons Irish Whisky, lime, smoky ginger ale

King Edward VII or 'Bertie' to his mum Queen Victorian was the eldest and most fun heir apparent, known for smoking twenty cigarettes and twelve cigars a day!

Horse Guard Joust

Ketel One vodka, lime, sugar, mint

Perfect Manhattan

First created for Winston Churchills mother in NYC and later perfected with balancing both sweet and dry vermouth and a drop of cherry

Negroni

Bombay Sapphire gin, sweet vermouth, Campari

A bitter Italian classic start to the evening with a generous spritz of orange zest

Old Fashioned

Bourbon, sugar, bitters

Our bourbon is infused for weeks in advance to marry the flavours and ensure you are not waiting an age for your drink to be mixed

Dark rum, mint, vanilla sugar
