



Dress Code

Members are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their guests are fully aware of the rules and that they are followed throughout their visit to the Golf Club.

On the Course

- Shirts – recognized golf shirts, with collar, to be worn and tucked into trousers/shorts at all times whilst on the course. Ladies' shirts to be worn as designed.
- Trousers & shorts – must be tailored. No denim, joggers, or cargo trousers/shorts.
- Ladies' shorts/capri trousers to be tailored.
- Hoodies – recognized golfing apparel hooded jumpers are allowed on the course and in the clubhouse. They are not to display large logos or numbers.
- Headgear – to be worn correctly (i.e. with peak facing forward)
- Shoes – recognized golf shoes, made and designed for golf are to be worn on the course – soft spikes only.

The above applies to course, practice and putting areas.

Clubhouse

- Smart casual attire can be worn including shorts.
- No football shirts
- Shirts can be untucked.
- No wet, muddy or waterproof clothing to be worn.
- Golf shoes, which are clean.
