Originally a dairy farm, Tewin Bury has been home to the Williams family since 1931.

## Introduction

The arable land continues to be farmed by Ivor Williams, while younger brother Vaughan focuses more on the hotel side, alongside our dedicated team of staff led by long-standing General Manager Salem Retibi.

A record of the remarkable heritage of Tewin Bury Farm and a visual history of its transformation can be seen in framed pictures dotted around the various buildings. All of the beautiful, quirky & rustic original features we love have been carefully maintained during renovations.

It was 1980 when, looking at ways to diversify the business, the family sold the dairy herd to purchase some neighbouring farm land.

A new Farm Shop was opened to sell their potatoes and other local produce and – as an experiment – four rooms in the family home were advertised as guest rooms available for visitors.

The demand for rooms grew, more renovation work took place and Tewin Bury Farm was born.



## Local Attractions

### Paradise Wildlife Park

An amazing array of animals for a great family day out.

### Harry Potter Studios

Check out the Warner Brothers Studios where all of the films were made! The tour includes everything from guides on special effects to a cafe serving real butter beer.

### Stanborough Lakes

Located just up the road from the Farm, the lakes are a great place for open-water swimming, rowing boats & kayaking - as well as much more! The inflatable assault course is also very popular & worth checking out...

### Hatfield House

Stunning gardens & boutique shops are just a couple of reasons to visit.

### London

A short trip from Welwyn North Station (just up the road) direct into Kings Cross (15-45 mins depending on which train).

### St Albans

A historic market town just down the road - filled with lively bars & restaurants, as well as some great retail therapy!

### Hertford

Another nearby town filled with bars & restaurants.

### Spirit of Herts

A local, boutique gin distillery selling small-batch bottles infused with locally foraged produce. They also have a Gin school if you fancy a class!

## Where to eat & drink?

### Farm Shop

Located in the old chicken shed, the shop provides fresh, local meat, produce & sweet treats - perfect to stock up on snacks or grab ingredients if you are in one of our self-catering rooms.

The bar & terrace also provides breakfast & lunch 7 days a week. Enjoy a tippie during the day while watching the world go by or catch up with friends on the Farm.

### Farm Yard

Our lively Farm Yard had humble beginnings as a pop-up gazebo serving burgers & cocktails in the Summer of 2020. Little did we know the buzz & excitement it would cause!

Following the successful start, private, heated, wooden huts were custom designed & built by our team to surround the new kitchen & bar, while a live music stage was added to host local talent.

The result is simply one of the most unique venues you are likely to see - a rocking atmosphere fuelled by live music at every session & upbeat tunes from our curated play lists in between. Cocktails, street food & cold draft beers complete the experience.

### Cowshed Restaurant

Renovated from the original building housing the dairy herd, our restaurant decor brings a contemporary edge to the rustic exterior.

Fine dining inspired by local produce from the area & our kitchen garden - available 7 days a week.

Our famous Afternoon Tea with homemade scones & sweet treats is also served here.

### The View Bar & Kitchen

Our industrial style sports bar at Panshanger golf course - just a short stroll across the road.

Serving up cocktails, small plates & street food - you won't find a better place for a casual bite while admiring the scenes across the 18th hole & further afield to Tewin Farm's land.

All the live sports are shown! So if there's a big football game - here's the place to be.

### Stable Piano Bar

Our eclectic Stable bar is filled with vibrant art from local artists, while live pianists join us every Friday & Saturday evening. A relaxing space to watch the world go by, read a book or grab a boardgame - be sure to enjoy a garden-to-glass cocktail on the riverside terrace too.
