SAMPLE WINE FLIGHT

Woodchester Valley Cotswold Way Sparkling 2018

Only 6 miles from us is the Woodchester Vineyard where this has been grown & produced and boasts fresh citrus notes, aromas of red apple. The lees ageing brings some aromas of pastry reminiscent of a delicious apple pie.

Tormaresca Chardonnay, Pietrabianca 2022

Full, intense, and structured with notes of white peach, ripe apple, and spice on the nose. The palate is powerful yet retains impressive precision and elegance.

Vecchie Vigne Verdicchio. Superiore, Umani Ronchie 2019

This fruity/aromatic and organic wine was created to preserve the great historical heritage of the old vineyards on the Montecarotto farm. 4 hectares of old vines were planted in the early 70s. It has a slight creamy finish.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, La Braccesca 2019

This wine offers pleasant fruity notes, sensations of raspberries and plums that merge with sweet aromas similar to vanilla. The palate is well balanced, soft, defined by ripe silky tannins. A lengthy and persistent finish.

Babich Family Estate Cowslip Valley Riesling 2019

This single vineyard organic Riesling is grown in our Cowslip Valley Vineyard in the Waihopai Valley, Marlborough. This cool, and sometimes frost prone site with moderately fertile silt soils helps to restrict vine vigour and create extraordinarily intense varietal characters with good body and complexity.

Aleatico Fattoria Aldobrandesca, Antinori 2020

Delicate aromas of wild roses merge with fruity aromas of cherries and plums. The palate is remarkable for its unique balance between sweetness and freshness, the finish is dominated by typical varietal notes of roses.
