Aromatic yet dry, this wine offers complex flavours of zesty citrus, gooseberry, subtle lychee and pineapple with a distinctive elderflower aroma. The finish is mouth-watering and incredibly refreshing. Perfect with seafood!

The geeky stuff...

Planted on the limestone soils of the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, **Woodchester Valley** is a family- owned vineyard and winery established by **Fiona Shiner** in 2007 when she planted an acre of vines at her home in Amberley.

The estate has now grown to 45 acres across three sites within the **Stroud Valleys** and produces a range of award-winning wines, most of which are **vegan-friendly** like this Bacchus.

Winemaker Jeremy Mount's experience includes time in Chablis, Napa Valley & Marlborough.

Well-rounded and harmonious, with notes of tinned peaches and fresh herbs, a fresh, juicy palate and a long, mouthwatering finish.

The geeky stuff...

The Dão river valley lays in the Silgueiros region which has been settled for 4000 years. Traces left by the Romans and Moors show that the wine was produced there long before Christ. Dão is one of Portugal's best-known and most prestigious appellations, having been formally set up in 1908.

The grapes are hand-picked by families and neighbours, then blended to make an enchanting wine.

This wine displays **ripe lemon** fruit with **white flowers** and herbs, the palate **crisp** and refreshing with **a long finish**.

The geeky stuff...

In the last years our Roseto degli Abruzzi estate, with mainly Montepulciano vineyards and a small part of Pecorino, has enriched the quality and tipicity of the grapes. Since the first harvest in this area we decide to cultivate the vineyards following the organic methods because we thought that the position, soil and climate were perfect for this kind of farming. In this area, the Centovie village from where we overlooked the estate for the first time in 2000, was born our Pecorino. A wine where, in our opinion, you can find all the elements of this amazing estate between the Gran Sasso mountain and the Adriatic coast.

Italy's north-eastern corner is home to its greatest concentration of fine white wines.

On the nose there are notes of apple, grapefruit and lemon, as well as a pleasant floral aroma. Smooth and full-bodied on the palate, with a long finish.

The geeky stuff...

Just 10 kilometres from the Italian border, in the viticultural paradise of Gorizia, 400 Slovenian families work together to make the Quercus wines. Vines have been cultivated here since before the time of the Romans and today they produce charming and great value examples of the same grape varieties on the other side of the border.

A sub-Mediterranean climate with a mixture of warm sea air and the influence of cold winds from the Alps.

Light in body yet intensely flavoured, this Grüner Veltliner offers the typical white pepper and crisp green fruit aromas of the variety, allied to a creamy texture particular to the Wagram region. The balance is really satisfying, the wine refreshing from start to finish.

The geeky stuff...

Arnold Holzer was born 1987 and as the fifth generation to do so, took over the winery from his parents in 2010. The Eschenhof Holzer winery is located in Großriedenthal, in the Wagram wine region. An innovative wine maker, Arnold draws on the unique bounty of nature, with a great deal of creativity, a distinctive style and a sense for delicious creations.

Zero-G is named in homage to the fearless mountain goats of the Wagram region.

Aromas of lime and stone fruit with a touch of Granny Smith apple and floral citrus notes. Fleshy and rich with a nervy drive, through to the botrytis bite on the dry finish. Lime, lemon and floral orange notes. Rich, complex and concentrated.

The geeky stuff...

In 1910, at 14 years old, **Josip Babich** emigrated from Dalmatia (part of modern day Croatia) to join his three brothers, who were digging and selling Kauri gum in New Zealand's far north. In 1911, the brothers put a deposit on land in Henderson Valley (West Auckland), which became the family homestead and winery. A year later, Josip planted his first vineyard on a terrace above the Kaikino Swamp gum field. Aged 20, in 1916 he made his first wine, under the name **Babich Brothers**. He quickly gained respect by having the desire to produce only the best quality wine, creating solid foundations for the company. Today, three generations of the family are committed to honouring his legacy.

In the early decades of the New Zealand wine industry, flagons were the standard way to bottle wine.

The geeky stuff...

In 1875, the first of the Valduga family arrived in Brazil, from the city of Rovereto, in northern Italy. They cultivated the first grapevines in the heart of what is today Vale dos Vinhedos, giving root to the legacy of one of Brazil's most renowned winemakers. The third generation of the family is in charge today.

The geeky stuff...

Maipo is home to Chile's greatest winemaking tradition. It has a temperate climate with a hot, dry summer. Frosts are rare in the valley, and rainfall is concentrated between April and September. Its rocky soils are of alluvial origin with good drainage and moderate fertility.

The Maipo Valley climate is beneficial to the developement of red wines, escpecially Cabernet Sauvignon.

The geeky stuff...

Richard Stewart Sr. (affectionately known as "Poppa Dick") settled in the Okanagan area in 1908. From working the land, he would go on to establish one of the valley's most successful nurseries. The first vines were planted in 1961 by his son, Dick, from then on Quail's Gate has become one of Canada's foremost family-owned estate wineries.

This single-vineyard Nebbiolo offers an elegant nose with hints of raspberries and roses. On the palate, it is full and harmonious with a long, positive finish.

The geeky stuff...

Alfredo Prunotto founded his business in 1922, and was one of Piemonte's most dynamic exporters until his retirement in 1956. The company passed then to Prunotto's friend Beppe Colla, now a revered winemaker and one of the founding fathers of modern Piemonte. His defining moment was the decision in 1961 to bottle single-vineyard, or cru, wines from the finest sites—a practice that is now the norm in the region. The Marchesi Antinori family first began its collaboration with the Prunotto Company, at first handling distribution, in 1989, and later, in 1994, when the Beppe retired, became directly involved in the production.

Given extra complexity with the addition to the blend of the special **Oseleta** grape, rediscovered by **Masi**, ageing in small oak casks accentuates its international style.

Rich, dry, velvety, complex and elegant.
