



PARKING IN WINCHESTER GUIDE

The Hotel has 2 carparks onsite, one of which is located at the front of the property on St Peters Street. The secondary 'overflow' car park is located at the rear of the property on Parchment Street. Both streets run parallel to each other either side of the property accessible via Winchesters one way system.

Please be aware due to our central location the hotel's car parking is limited and due to this reason, all parking is available on a 'first-come first-served basis' and therefore we cannot guarantee or reserve parking spaces for any of our patrons/guests.

Parking is chargeable at £12 for overnight parking and £8 for day use parking.

Both car parks are managed by a barrier, guests can enter both carparks by driving on the barrier and it will automatically lift allowing access to the carpark. An exit code is required for departure, this can be obtained from reception.

If there is signage stating "Car-Park Full" then please use the alternate local parking, do not enter through the barrier as this will create unnecessary delays and issues when trying to exit the car park without an exit code.

If the car parks are full, we advise driving to the front of the Hotel (on St. Peter Street) to drop your luggage off before proceeding to one of the local car parks.

Please be aware that if you are planning to arrive early to secure parking at the hotel this does not mean that parking will be available due to our check-out time of 11am and we may also have multiple night stays using the car park. Regrettably we also cannot allow vehicles to be left in the Hotel car park once you have checked out.
